07 Economics

- The study of economics helps the students to understand the world around them. It enables them to understand people, business, markets and governments, and therefore better respond to the treats and opportunities that emerge when things change.
- A students of economics will effectively visualise, conceptualise, articulate, and solve problems and also address various decision-making problems with available information through experimental and observation, using microeconomics and macroeconomics theory as well as calculus and statistical tools.
- Economics students will understand how to apply empirical evidence to economic arguments. They may obtain or collect relevant data, develop empirical evidence using appropriate statistical techniques and interpret the result of such analysis.
- A students of economics will broaden their global and disciplinary knowledge, enhancing their understanding of the world around them both within economics and beyond.
