Physical Academic and Support Facilities

1. Laboratory

The U.G. Science departments, viz. Anthropology, Food and Nutrition, Zoology, Botany, Microbiology, Physics, Chemistry etc. purchase their respective raw materials (like instruments, chemicals, preserved specimens, food ingredients etc.) and maintains them through stock registers. This helps students in carrying out their practical works efficiently. The stock of specimens are maintained and the instruments are periodically calibrated and properly maintained. Teaching aids like charts, 3 dimensional models, videos, flash cards, overhead projectors and slides are demonstrated to the students while in class or during field work by the science departments as well as the departments of Education, Geography etc. All science departments regularly maintain respective log books for their lab based instruments.

2. Library

The KOHA version 3.14.06.000 has been installed since 2016. Various e-journals and e-books have been made available through the subscription of INFLIBNET. The record of total number of books, journals and publications available is maintained by the Central library. The library also maintains a log book to record the daily footfall of the students and teachers of the college. Students can borrow books on the basis of day and home issue. The log for teachers and students are maintained separately. The library keeps a regularly updated repertory of university question papers of all streams and hard copies of academic journals.

3. Sports Complex

Our sports arena comprises of a playground of 40 cottahs, where the students play games like football, volleyball, cricket, badminton etc. Annual sports competition is also held here. Indoor games like table tennis, carrom, chess etc. are made available to the students within the campus. A MoU has been recently signed between our institution and the Pakre Cricket Academy for offering professional training to students.

4. Computers

All science, arts and commerce departments have their individual desktops and laptops to be used for departmental activities. Departments of Computer Science, Physics, Journalism and Mass Communications, Geography, Mathematics enjoy the privilege of having individual computer laboratories. There is a browsing centre in the hostel building. The institution has signed a MoU with the WEBEL Informatics Limited who offers low cost computer training to the students of our college. An internet connection is provided by the college with a bandwidth of 260 Mbps.

5. Class rooms

The college has well equipped classrooms to facilitate teaching-learning process. The rooms are of varied sizes and departments have been allotted specific rooms in accordance to their roll strength. Teaching aids like white boards, projectors, charts, notice boards, almirahs and shelves for departmental/seminar libraries are provided.

6. Gymnasium

The institution has two fully equipped gymnasiums, for boys and girls respectively. Two instructors have been appointed for training purpose.

7. Canteen

A canteen at a subsidised rate is functional for students and teachers. Healthy and hygenic food is provided for everyone.

8. Sick Room Facility

The Red Cross Unit of the college maintains a sick room with basic first aid and medical facilities for the students, teachers and non-teaching staffs of the college.
