Best Practice-1

Evidence of Success

- The students acquired various kinds of skills, like non IT students were benefited by learning ICT skills
- Feedback collected from the students showed their interests in professional courses
- Students enrolled themselves for courses provided by Anudip Foundation.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required

- Paucity of funds becomes a challenge in the long run for the continuation of the programme
- Overall lack of awareness about skill development programmes
- Securing financial assistance to ensure sustainability of these initiatives.

Evidence of Success

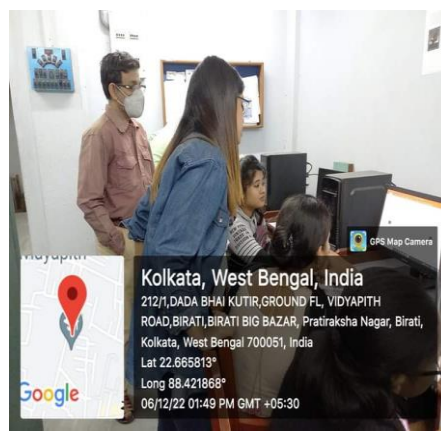
- The students were enthusiastic in planting and nurturing trees within the college campus.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required

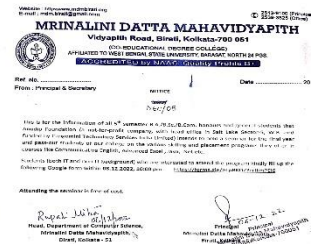
- Climate issues and the socio-economic background of our students pose a challenge to carry out the outdoor awareness programmes, organised by the institution.
- Students’ need adequate training and knowledge regarding the importance of protecting environment.



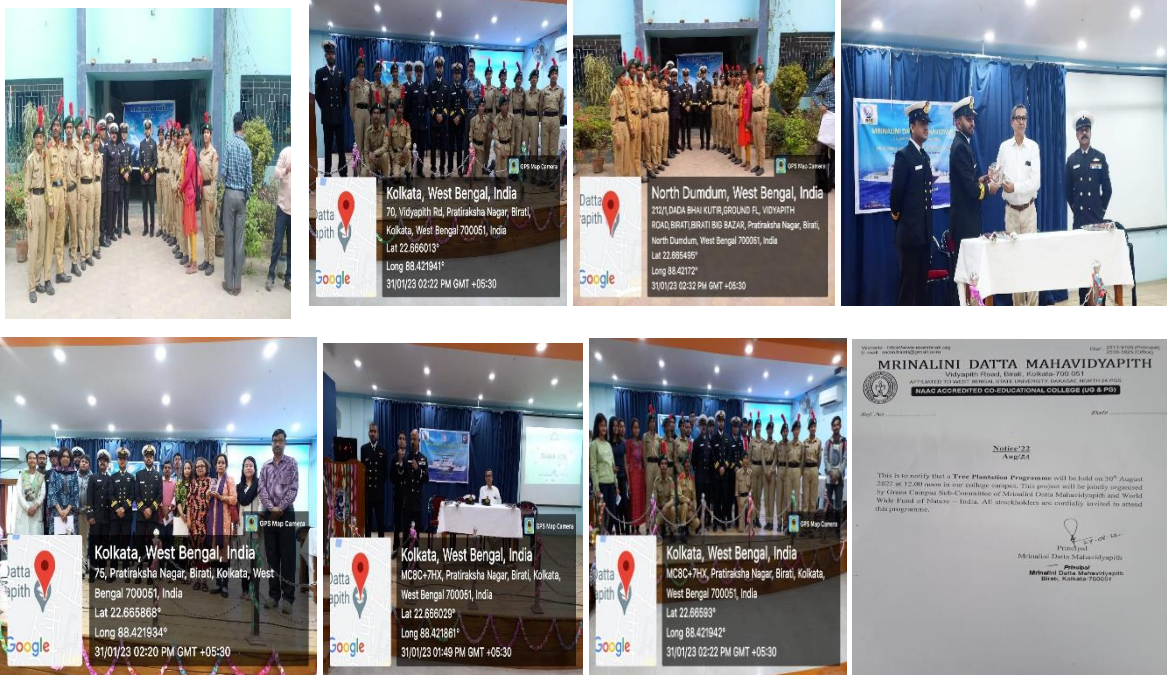
An Orientation Programme and Demonstration entitled, Fine Tuning Language



Two-Day Workshop, ICT Computing Skills, organized by the Departments of English and Computer Science on 06/12/2022 and 07/12/2022



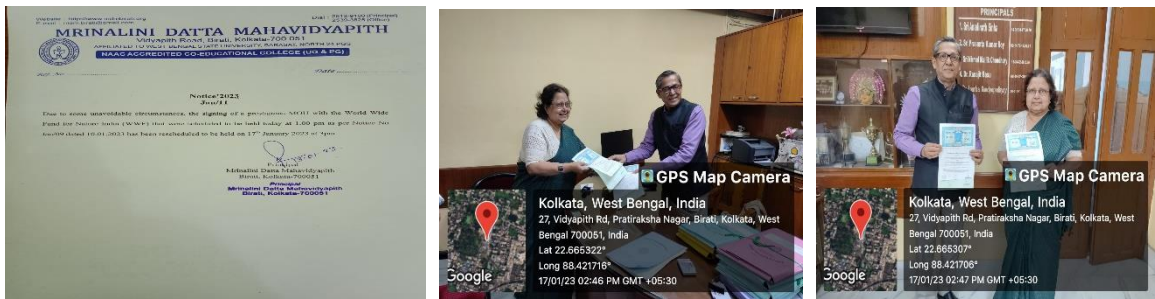

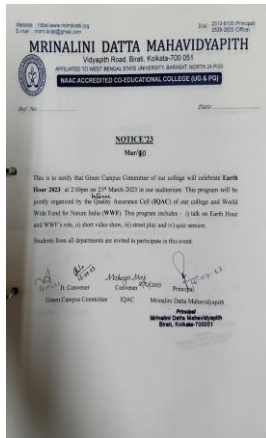
An awareness cum interactive session entitled Life Service and Career with the Indian Coast Guards organized by the NCC Unit and Indian Coast Guard on 31/01/2023
