






Merits of E-Learning Pertinent to the Lecture Delivered 32 responses



AUDIENCE FEEDBACK


The feedback revealed that the audience belonged to various age groups, disciplines and educational backgrounds. A large majority of the audience found the lectures highly beneficial.




Degree Pursuing / Pursued 320 responses




Semester (if College/University Student) 344 responses




How did you come to know about the lecture (s)? 352 responses
