- The IQAC of the college along with the Seminar Subcommittee and the Departments of Commerce and Economics had organised a legal awareness programme entitled, “Consumer Rights and Responsibilities” on 23.11.22, in order to enlighten the students about various legal procedures involved in seeking consumer protection. The JIS University acted as our prestigious collaborator.
- A National Seminar entitled “Understanding Human Rights in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Theory and Practice” was organised by the department of Political Science in association with IQAC and Seminar Subcommittee on 20.12.22 to disseminate knowledge and instil awareness regarding human rights and its protection. The programme was organised in collaboration with Centre for Studies of South and South-East Asian Societies, Kazi Nazrul University.
- The Internal Complaint’s Committee in collaboration with the IQAC of our college had organised an awareness programme on “Sexual Harassment of Woman at Workplace” on 12.05.23. Smt. Soumi Guha Thakurta, Advocate High Court Kolkata had enlightened the students on the POSH Act and the redressal mechanisms available to the victims. Students walled various posters to create awareness.
- An online add-on-course on “Human Rights and Gender Studies” was conducted by the three departments of our college English, Political Science and Sociology in collaboration with the Centre for Studies in Gender, Culture and Media, West Bengal State University where many lectures tried to shed light on the legal intricacies related to human rights in general and women and LGBTQ rights in particular.

**Eligibility Criteria**  
UG students of Semesters 2, 4 & 6 and PG Students of Semesters 2 & 4 of any discipline and other interested academicians/professionals can apply for the course.

**Number of Seats**  
90 students on the first-come-first-serve basis will be enrolled for the course.

**Course Fee**  
The course fee is Rs. 200 for the students of Mrinalini Datta Mahavidyapith and Kazi Nazrul University (KNU). The fee for students of other institutions is Rs.400 and interested academicians/professionals will have to pay Rs.500 for the entire course.
