

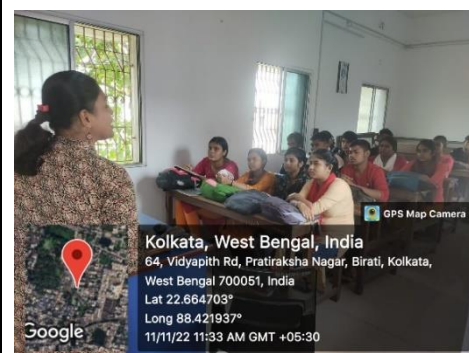

Infrastructure and Physical facilities for teaching-learning

Classrooms:

Every department of the college has its own class room. The classrooms are of different sizes to accommodate students in accordance with their roll strength. Teaching aids used include white boards, projectors, charts, notice boards, almirah, shelves etc. for every department. There are two ICT class rooms in the college.



Laboratory:

College has well equipped department specific laboratory. The U.G. Science departments, viz. Anthropology, Food and Nutrition, Zoology, Botany, Microbiology, Physics, Chemistry etc. purchase their respective raw materials (like instruments, chemicals, preserved specimens, food ingredients etc.). This helps students in carrying out their practical works efficiently. The stock of specimens is Maintained and the instruments are periodically calibrated and properly maintained. Teaching aids like charts, 3dimensional models, videos, flash cards, overhead projectors and slides are demonstrated to the students while in class or during field work by the science departments as well as the departments of Education, Geography etc.



Library:

The KOHA version 22.05.13.000 has been installed since 2023. Various e-journals and e-books have been made available through the subscription of INFLIBNET. Both the teachers and students have access to INFLIBNET service. The record of total number of books, journals and publications available is maintained by the Central library. The library maintains log book to record the daily footfall of the students and teachers of the college. Students can borrow books from the library and keep it for 15 days. There is also provision for renewing the books twice. The log for teachers and students is maintained separately. There is a separate area in the library often used by the teachers for reading at the library. The library keeps updated repertory of university question papers of all streams and hard copies of academic journals.



Computing equipment:

There is a computer lab in the hostel building of the college for the students. There is a computer lab in the main building equipped for Diploma course offered by the Webel Informatics Ltd. Computer science department has well maintained lab. Besides, every department has their own computer and laptop to facilitate students. Office of the college also has computers for supporting administrative works.



Conference and seminar hall:

There is an auditorium used for organising academic and cultural programmes. Two conference rooms are there for organising seminars, workshops, special lecture programmes and meetings.
