

An inter-college lecture on Monsoon Mechanism in India was conducted by Department of Geography in collaboration with Sarada Ma Girls College.





The study of algorithms forms the core of computer science. There can be multiple ways/ algorithms to solve a problem and each method has its own advantages and limitations. This lecture exposed the students to the concepts of parallel and dynamic programming and their application in DNA sequencing. Starting from very easy to understand concepts like chicken-and-egg problem, Fibonacci numbers etc, the speaker slowly and lucidly built up to complex concepts like how sub problems may be used to reach answer to a bigger and otherwise difficult to handle problems.



Date: 02.09.2020



Date: 05.09.2020


