





Webinar 10

Title: An Application of Parallel Dynamic Programming in DNA Sequencing

Date: 28.07.2020

The study of algorithms forms the core of computer science. There can be multiple ways/ algorithms to solve a problem and each method has its own advantages and limitations. A student of this field must know about the different types of algorithms like recursive, dynamic, parallel, divide-and-conquer etc. Dynamic and parallel programming techniques re-use previously calculated results for future computations. This lecture exposed the students to the concepts of parallel and dynamic programming and their application in DNA sequencing. Starting from very easy to understand concepts like chicken-and-egg problem, Fibonacci numbers etc, the speaker slowly and lucidly built up to complex concepts like how sub problems may be used to reach answer to a bigger and otherwise difficult to handle problems.



DNA sequencing and COVID-19

- First genome sequencing is a vital and rapidly-developing tool in the diagnosis of COVID-19 and in understanding the spread and control of the novel coronavirus.
- A genome - an organism's genetic material - is essentially its construction manual, which contains all the information needed to make and maintain it.
- Human genomes are made of double-stranded DNA.
- In contrast, a virus genome can either be made of DNA or of its close cousin RNA.
- If the virus genome's sequence is found as a single (or only a few) times from the same sequence, it will indicate the likelihood that a patient's symptoms are those of COVID-19.
- If virus genome sequencing is undertaken rapidly and on a large scale then, it can assist epidemiologists and public health authorities in understanding how the virus is spreading and in evaluating how effective those interventions have been.
- It can also help to establish whether new variants are associated with particular patterns of symptoms or severity of disease.
